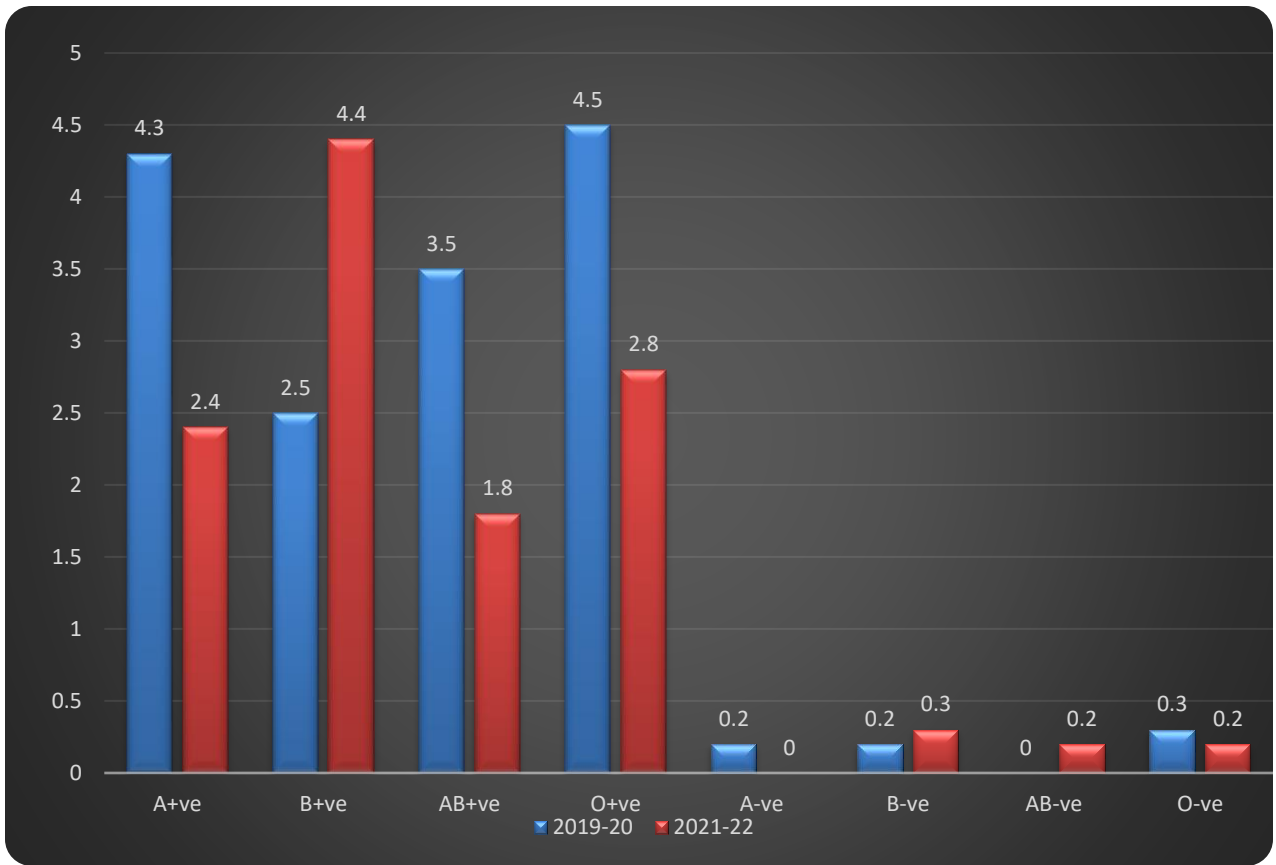
#### **HEALTH SERVICES (Blood Pressure and Hemoglobin Checkup)**

Blood group and hemoglobin checkup is a best practice of our college.

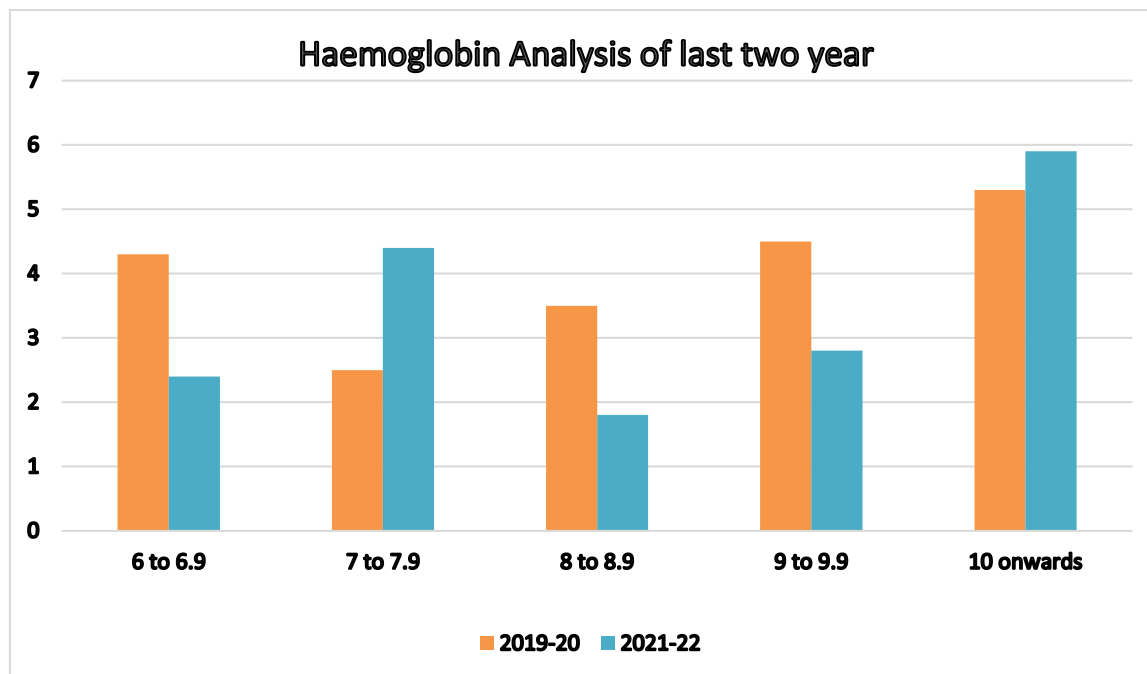



Outstanding achievers and recently passed out students in competitive exams are invited as resource persons /chief guests

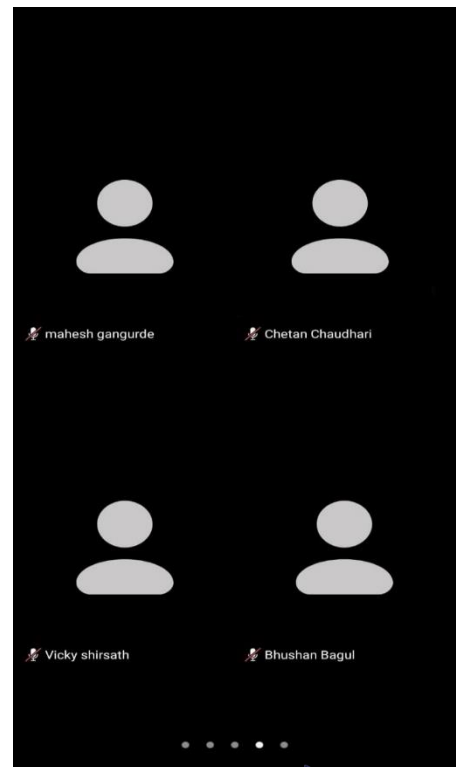
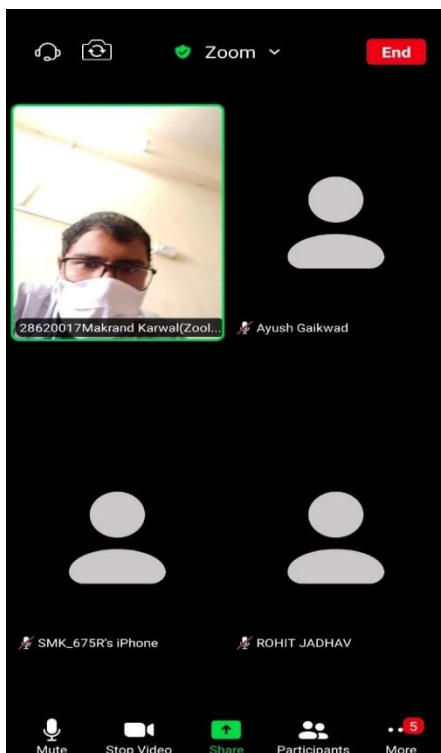
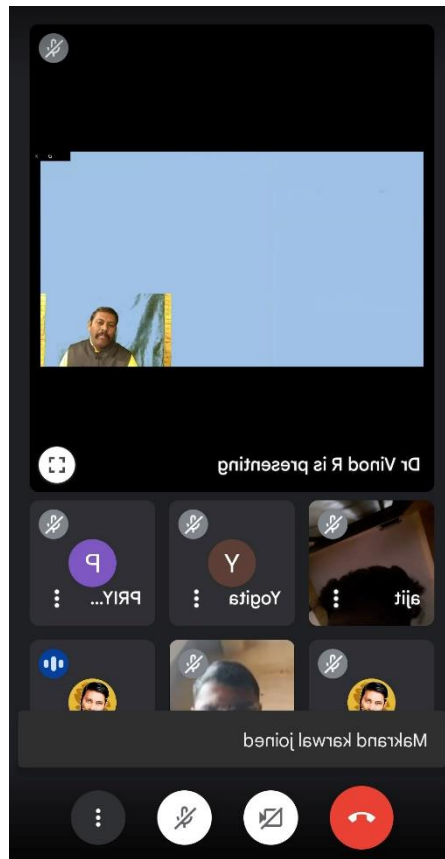
